



SERVING STUDENTS, SUPPORTING SCHOOLS

Our high school ministry is woven into the life of our local campuses in a real, everyday way. We're present at six local schools through student-led clubs that give teenagers a place to grow in faith and find community. On Friday nights, our team hosts BBQ tailgates for students and staff at West Park and Twelve Bridges football games, creating a place where people can hang out, eat, and feel valued. We also run the Panther Pantry at West Park, making sure students who need food, clothing, or athletic gear can get it without any barriers or embarrassment.

Thanksgiving Break arrives and some students miss the meals they usually get at school, we resource them so **no one goes hungry**. We partner with football teams, the band, and more by providing **team dinners that build connection** and show support. And throughout the year, we make it a point to **appreciate teachers and staff** who pour themselves into the next generation. **Our goal is to make every campus feel seen, supported, and loved**.
