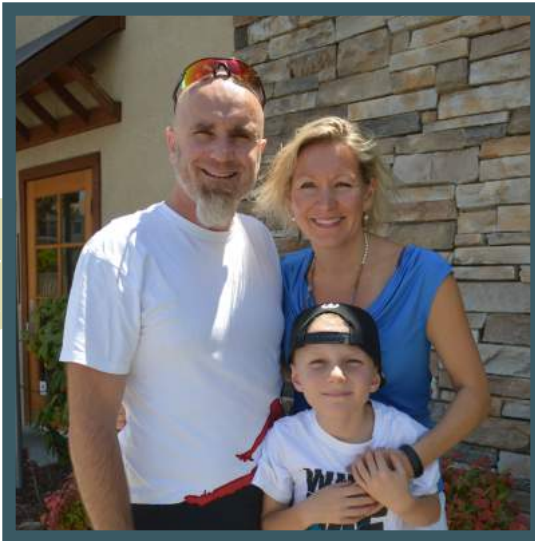
# Christian Associates, Parfums de Vie

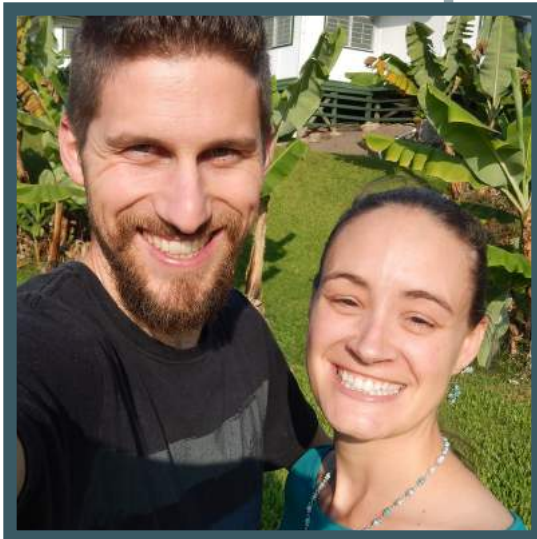


# Wycliffe

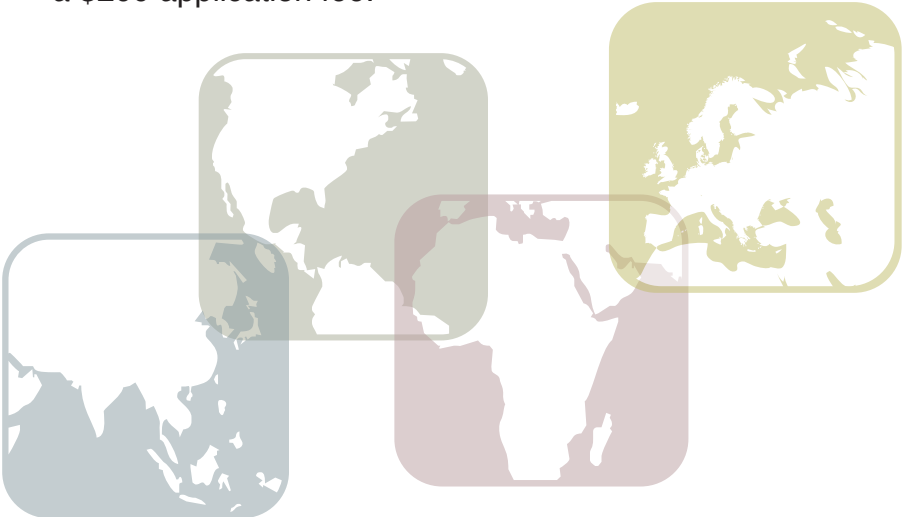
